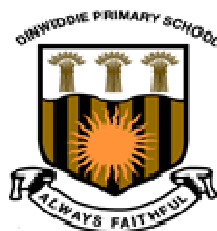

## SAFETY AND SECURITY

Dinwiddie Primary adheres to a ruling from the District Office that for safety and security reasons, a parent collecting a child during the course of the school day must produce his/her ID document when signing the child out.
