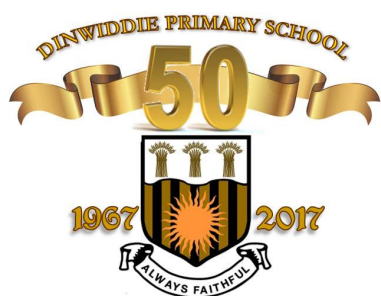

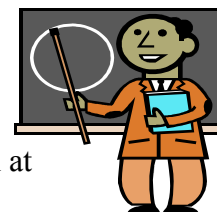
Dear Parents
