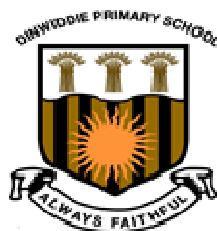

The budget for the 2020 year was accepted at the AGM held on 13 November 2019. We repeat the details of school fees and aftercare fees for the 2020 year.

* A 12% discount will apply if fees for 2020 are paid <u>in full</u> by 31 December 2019 (Grade 1 R9 592 Grades 2 to 7 R9 284)	
* An 8% discount will apply if fees for 2020 are paid <u>in full</u> by 31 January 2020. (Grade 1 R10 028 Grades 2 to 7 R9 706)	
* A 5% discount will apply if fees for 2020 are paid <u>in full</u> by 29 February 2020. (Grade 1 R10 355 Grades 2 to 7 R10 023)	

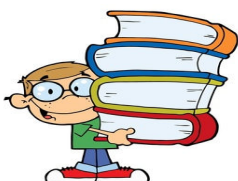
2. Kidz Village Adventure Centre (Aftercare) fees are as follows:
